



The activities of the coalition are based upon annually-evaluated regional needs, the Healthcare Preparedness Capabilities developed by ASPR (Assistant Secretary of Preparedness and Response), and the North Carolina Office of EMS. Within the region, MAHPC is guided by an elected Steering Committee with additional input from regional partners. Coalition activities have included annual regional exercises, coordination of education and training, development of decontamination capabilities within hospitals and EMS, and the provision of Viper Medical Network radios to all hospitals and EMS partners.

MAHPC strives to meet all disaster-related educational and training needs, including incident command system (ICS), hospital incident command system (HICS), disaster/mass casualty triage, facility evacuation, disaster medical care, decontamination, emergency preparedness and response, and disaster communications.



WHO ARE WE

- MAHPC is one of eight coalitions in North Carolina developed to aid in regional disaster preparedness and response.
- Includes over 80 healthcare agencies in the 19 westernmost counties. (Including EBCI)
- Comprised of regional healthcare partners such as hospitals, EMS, public health, emergency management, public safety and other healthcare entities.



SMAT & MRC


The MAHPC State Medical Assistance Team (SMAT) and Mountain Regional Medical Reserve Corps (MRMRC) is a multidisciplinary volunteer team of medical and nonmedical professionals, established to provide mobile medical support for short and long-term disasters or catastrophic events.

SMAT members are typically sponsored by the healthcare organization for which they work, Medical Reserve Corps members are strictly volunteers that support the program in the same manner.
