

AVAILABLE RESOURCES

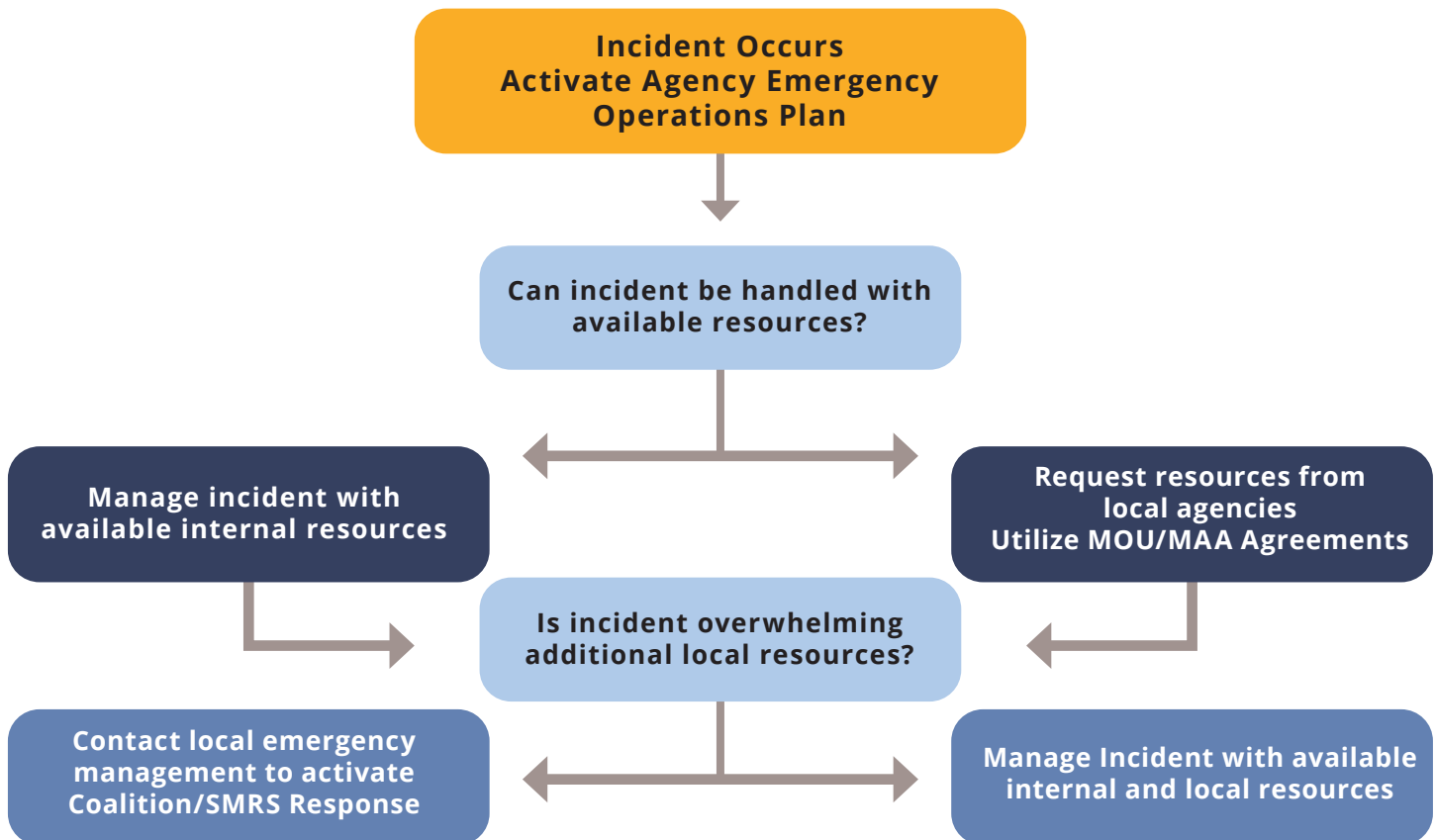
The Mountain Area Healthcare Preparedness Coalition (MAHPC) and cache of medical disaster-response equipment for North Carolina's westernmost counties is located in a 25,000 square-foot warehouse in Flat Rock (Henderson County). The strategic location of the building allows for rapid regional distribution to the Coalition area and neighboring states. North Carolina was the first in the United States to develop regional caches and response teams. The North Carolina Office of Emergency Medical Services works to ensure equipment and personnel packages are scaled to the necessary level of response.

- Cooling/Misting Fans
- Patient Decontamination Unit

- Zoll EMS Cardiac Monitors
- "Bear Hugger" Patient Warming Systems
- Ambulance Strike Team Support Trailer
- 40 Ventilators (*adult & pediatric*)
- 36 Portable Suction Units
- Cache of Defibrillators
- Medication Go-packs
- 3.5 Ton HVAC Units
- Heating Package (*for facility loss of HVAC*)
- Multiple Options for Cooling & Rehab
- General Patient Care Supplies for up to 72 Hours
